Volumes I and II

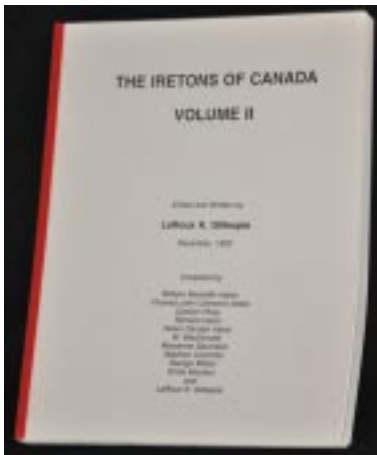


The families of Iretons from Ireland and England landed in Canada in the early 1800s. With the help of 10 descendants *The Iretons of Canada Vol. I* describes the history and relationships of 7 different lines of these families in Canada. In 312 pages we chronicle their lives and an abbreviated genealogy for them. Their details are documented in almost 600 references from the over 3000 we have collected on Iretons around the world.

A brief history of Iretons in Ireland and in England starts the book, and then families are discussed by the cities or counties they are in. Beginning with Lanark, then Leeds, and places like Verulam, Lindsay, Moose Jaw, and Gray County. One Urton family is also included among our Iretons.

This is the most complete picture of Iretons in Canada you will find. It is based on years of research and is a companion to other books about the Iretons of New Zealand, Ireland, the US and in the future about those from England. While you will follow the

genealogy, this is a history of those Iretons. *The Iretons of Canada, Vol. II* is a 350 page compendium of just genealogy of these families. An index to all persons mentioned is included at the end of volume II.



The Ireton Newsletter is a 25 year newsletter of all Iretons in the world and it contains a number of Canadian Ireton tidbits that go beyond the material contained in volume I.
